Reel 32 bars 8 times for 3 couples in a 4 couple set. Suggested music: MacPhail's Magic.

- 1 2 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} men advance.
- 3 4 1st, 2nd and 3rd men retire, while 1st, 2nd and 3rd women advance.
- 5 6 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} men advance, while 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} women retire.
- 7 8 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} men retire.
- 9 16 1st cpl. cast off followed by 2nd and 3rd cpl., dance up the middle, 1st and 2nd cpl. ready for an allemande, 3rd cpl. out to places.
- 17-24 1st and 2nd cpl. dances a beautiful allemande.
- 25-32 2^{nd} , 1^{st} and 3^{rd} couple six hands round and back.

P.S. In a 3 cpl. set: bars 9 – 16: 1st cpl. cast off followed by 2nd and 3rd cpl., dance up the middle, then 1st cpl cast off 1 place ready for an allemande with 3rd cpl., 2nd cpl. end in first place.
